

From the Health Office:

For your information, the New York State Public Health Law for the use of tick and insect repellents at children's camp has been amended to:

- Allow a camper to carry and use repellents with written permission from the camper's parent or guardian.
- Allow unlicensed personnel to assist a child who is unable to apply the repellent when directed by the child if permitted by the parent or guardian, and authorized by the camp.
- Park Shore will maintain a record of the parent or guardian permission.

Park Shore will store tick & insect repellent at the Health Office (unless the child is attending travel camp)

Please remember to label your child's tick and insect repellent.
