



Dear Park Shore Parents,

As the warmer weather rapidly approaches us, the need for sunscreen application is important. NYS Public Health Law allows a child attending a children's camp to use sunscreen when it is used to protect against over exposure to the sun, the sunscreen is approved by the FDA for over the counter use, and the child's parent or guardian provides written permission to carry and use sunscreen. That being said we at Park Shore must maintain records of the parental/guardian permission and allows unlicensed personnel (camp staff) to assist with the application when the child is unable to do so.

The bottom of this form also has a section where you may indicate any special instructions you may have. Please tear off the permission form and return it to our camp.
